CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE We are so pleased to report that 98 pledges for over \$184,000 have been made by Trinity families toward our three-year goal of \$210,000. Of those pledges over \$102,000 has been received. Thank you for your pledges.

The phone-a-thon for the Honor Serve Provide Capital Campaign has been completed. Over 300 calls were made during four sessions to Trinity congregation members resulting in \$32,250 in pledges. 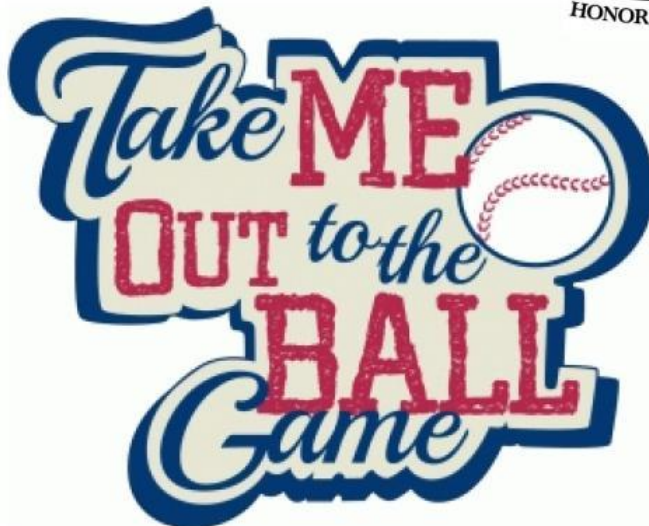
