**CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE** In the seven weeks since the kick-off dinner, 103 individuals and families have contributed to the capital campaign. We now have donations and pledges for over \$188,750 toward our \$210,000 goal. \$109,200 has already come in and shortly the church carpet will be replaced – by the way it will still be red.

We had help from the boy scouts (THANK YOU) to improve the lighting for one set of lights in the church parking lot. It makes such a big difference already. The second set will be upgraded in July. The Board of Properties is working on bids for glass repair for both church and school as well as renovation of the science room.

Our thanks to our donors and a wide variety of people from the church and school who are getting the projects completed once funding is available. You are all making this campaign a success.
