PRAYERLINE UPDATE Your prayer requests are important. Just as important is keeping the prayer requests updated for our volunteers who are praying. Recall when you put someone on Trinity's Prayerline, that person is being prayed for everyday by a Prayerline volunteer. Individuals from the Prayerline contact you to receive current information about those for whom are being lifted up to the Lord.

Separately, if you want the name of the individual for whom you have requested prayers to be listed in the bulletin, please call the church office and make sure you give us a contact number and why we are praying for that person. (This is a request from Trinity's ministry staff.) Why have a separate listing? This is so others in the congregation who are not a part of the Prayerline ministry may lift up prayers for these individuals. For those individuals who are listed in the bulletin, their names will be in there for a limited time. Periodically, we will begin again with new bulletin requests. Should you find that your individual no longer is listed and you would like to see their name in the bulletin again, please submit a new request by contacting the church office. Note, this does not affect those requests that have been submitted to the Prayerline, only those names requested to be printed in the bulletin.
